Position Description

The Boston College [Theology Department](#) announces a full-time faculty opening in Christian Theology at the rank of Assistant Professor of the Practice. This is a full-time non-tenure-track position with a three-year renewable contract. The position's responsibilities include teaching two sections each year of the year-long undergraduate course "[Perspectives on Western Culture](#)," which studies core and foundational texts in Philosophy and Theology and which fulfills the undergraduate core requirements of six credits in Theology and six credits in Philosophy. Applicants should have a strong teaching record and a commitment to excellence in teaching at the undergraduate level.

This position is an appointment within the [Theology Department](#) and the successful candidate will participate fully in the academic life of the Department. The promotion process will proceed through the Theology Department.

This appointment will begin in July 2024, with teaching duties beginning mid-August 2024.

Completion of PhD required by August 31, 2024.
