

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF THEOLOGY, OLD TESTAMENT/HEBREW SCRIPTURES

The Department of Theology and Philosophy at Barry University invites applicants for a full-time continuing contract position in the field of Old Testament/Hebrew Scriptures at the assistant professor level, beginning in August 2022. The position requires an earned Ph.D. or S.Th.D. in Old Testament/Hebrew Scriptures with the ability to teach graduate and undergraduate courses in theology, to advise and mentor students, to engage in scholarly work, and to serve on departmental, college, and university committees.

Responsibilities include a 3-3 undergraduate and/or graduate level teaching load, including but not limited to introduction to theology and Old Testament and its interpreters at the undergraduate level and Psalms, Prophetic Literature, and Wisdom Literature at the graduate level. Active involvement in the department's theological graduate programs and participation in the collegial and intellectual life of the university are required.

The position is open with regard to area of specialization, methodological commitments, and ecclesial location. However, facility with Catholic biblical hermeneutics and the ability to correlate the relationship between scripture and ministry are preferred. Additional responsibilities include academic advising and mentoring to undergraduate and graduate students, supervision of thesis projects, departmental and college service, university service, community service, and sustained scholarship.
