

The KÖLNER HOCHSCHULE FÜR KATHOLISCHE THEOLOGIE (KHKT) – COLOGNE UNIVERSITY OF CATHOLIC THEOLOGY (CUCT) addresses the academic, social and religious aspects of theology as a scientific field. The university embraces the interdisciplinary nature of theology in its fundamental principles and methods and fosters innovative, independent and creative education and instruction through a wide range of activities, including a strong emphasis on international exchange in the areas of academic research, teaching and study. A central tenet of KHKT's mission is the dialogue between theology and the Church and the scientific community, politics, society and culture. Compensation is based on Germany's W 2 or W 3 salary scale for professors (depending on qualifications). Employment is subject to social security contributions.

We are seeking an individual with impeccable qualifications (Doctorate in Catholic Theology; relevant teaching credentials [post-doctoral lecturing qualification – Habilitation – or equivalent]; outstanding published works; experience in interdisciplinary work and securing research funding), higher education expertise and, ideally, international experience. Qualified candidates must fully represent all of the Department of Ecclesiastical History's education and research efforts and be eager to play an active role in the development of the university and its overarching identity spanning multiple theological disciplines. Participation in the university's self-government is expected. KHKT expressly encourages qualified female candidates to apply. Persons with severe disabilities will be given preferential consideration if equally qualified.
