<b>Description</b>	Loyola Marymount University, Department of Theological Studies, announces a tenure-track faculty position in Practical/Pastoral Theology at the level of Assistant Professor, to begin in the Fall Semester, 2023. The successful candidate should be able to teach a variety of courses related to a Catholic practical theology that engages ecumenical and interreligious perspectives, and with attention to pastoral ministry in the diverse, Latina/o/x-dominant context of the Americas.

Candidates must be prepared to teach courses in theology or spirituality at the undergraduate level and courses in practical theology theory and contextual (field) education at the graduate level. The department is open to different areas of research expertise including not only ministry in Latinx/Hispanic but also in Black/African American, Asian American/Pacific Islander, or Native American/indigenous contexts; spirituality or spiritual direction; religious education; hospital or prison chaplaincy; or youth and young adult ministry. LMU greatly values diversity, engaged scholarship, and inclusive pedagogy in fostering academic excellence.

The position involves undergraduate teaching in the University Core, the Theological Studies Major and Minor programs, as well as in the MA in Theology and MA in Pastoral Theology programs. The teaching load is defined as 2-2-2-3 over two years (i.e. two classes per regular semester and three classes every fourth semester) Applicants must show promise of excellence in both teaching and research. A Ph.D. or other relevant doctoral degree (e.g., Th.D. or D.Min.) from an accredited institution is required.

The application deadline is October 15, 2022 at 5:00 pm (PST).

Interested applicants are invited to send: 1) a cover letter (outlining areas of teaching and research interests and resonance with LMU's mission, especially with respect to diversity and inclusion and working with underrepresented populations); 2) a curriculum vitae; 3) a statement of teaching philosophy and research interests; 4) a sample of scholarly writing; 5) a copy of doctoral work transcripts; 6) three letters of recommendation. Materials 1 through 5 must be uploaded at the time of application. Only online applications will be accepted.

The three letters of recommendation (requirement 6) also have a deadline of October 15, 2022 at 5:00 pm.
