

AD FOR THE APPROVED POSITION (1-3 YEARS) IN MORAL THEOLOGY

Job title: Assistant Professor, Department of Theology

The Department of Theology at Saint Anselm College, a Roman Catholic undergraduate liberal arts college in the Benedictine tradition in Manchester, NH invites applications for a one to three year faculty position in Roman Catholic moral theology to begin in August 2019. The successful candidate will teach Medical Ethics, Christian Social Ethics and Liberation Theology, as well as other courses in Roman Catholic moral theology and Scripture. The candidate will also teach *Conversatio*, a multidisciplinary first-year course providing every Saint Anselm student a shared learning experience in the Liberal Arts. Submit a letter of interest, curriculum vitae, evidence of teaching ability and research potential (samples of scholarship, articles or conference papers) and academic transcripts to the attention of Dr. Ahida E. Pilarski, Theology Department Chair, via the college website at www.anselm.edu/hr. Three letters of recommendation are required and should be submitted in PDF format via email to the department faculty assistant, Denise Reagan at denreagan@anselm.edu. Applications should be received by April 1 for full consideration. Candidates will be interviewed over Skype between April 15th and 19th. Finalists will be invited to an on campus interview in May.

Required Skills: A Ph.D. in Roman Catholic moral theology is required. Candidates should demonstrate a strong commitment to excellence in teaching at the undergraduate level as well as scholarly research.

Required Experience: Teaching experience at the undergraduate level is preferred.

Successful candidates will be able to assist the college in furthering its Catholic identity and its strategic goals for institution-wide diversity and inclusiveness.
