

Julia Brumbaugh is Associate Professor of Religious Studies at Regis University in Denver, Colorado, where she has taught since 2004. She holds a Ph.D. from Fordham University, where her dissertation work focused on the theology of tradition of Yves Congar in light of postmodern feminist challenges. She is co-editor with Natalia Imperatori-Lee of *Turning to the Heavens and the Earth: Theological Reflections on a Cosmological Conversion: Essays in Honor of Elizabeth A. Johnson* (Liturgical Press, 2016). Today, her research and teaching converge on questions of theological tradition in relation to reform, suffering, and Christian spiritual traditions, particularly Ignatian and Benedictine. She is also Vice President of the College Theology Society.
